

200 CLUB RULES

V2.0

- 1) The name of the club is the Team Bath Buccaneers Hockey Club 200 Club. Hereafter called 'the club'. The club is based at the University of Bath, Claverton Down, Bath.
- 2) The club is formed to raise funds for the general purpose of the Team Bath Buccaneers Hockey Club. Hereafter called 'the hockey club'.
- 3) Applications for membership of the club shall be made to - The Competition Secretary.
- 4) The competition is restricted to 200 members only and will run in periods of one year commencing in September. The competition will be run providing a minimum of 40 members has enrolled. If there are less than 40 members the competition will not be run that year.
- 5) Subscription rate is £24 annually to be paid by monthly standing order of £2 or cheque for £24. Standing order forms are attached for return to the competition secretary, via team captains, if necessary. Entry into the draw will be on completion of payment of the monthly subscription by either method.
- 6) Each member will be allocated a number from 1 to 200 and this number cannot be changed within the competition. The member will become an associate member of the hockey club enjoying the normal privileges of that class of membership of the club.
- 7) The management of the club shall be vested in the Executive Committee of the Hockey club, whose decision shall be final in any matter requiring adjudication. The Executive Committee shall have power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion.
- 8) Draws be held on the following basis:
 - a) If the club has 50 members but less than 80 at the start of the competition there will be;
 - 12 Monthly draws of £22.50
 - 4 quarterly draws of £50
 - 2 half yearly draws of £75
 - 1 annual Christmas draw of £100
 - b) If the club has 80 members up to the limit of 200 at the start of the competition there will be;
 - 12 monthly draws of £22.50
 - 4 quarterly draws of £75
 - 2 Half yearly draws of £100
 - 1 annual Christmas draw of £200
- 9) The competition secretary shall arrange as necessary additional draws in the year to ensure that the total prize monies represent 55% of the income, after administrative expenses, made to the club base on the number of members at the start of the year as defined above.
- 10) The winner of each draw will be notified by e-mail.
- 11) The 200 club's accounts will be available for inspection on request to the Hon. Treasurer of the hockey club. All surplus income over expenditure shall be paid to the Hockey club.
- 12) If necessary the competition will be registered under the Small Gaming and Lotteries legislation.
